29th September - SUNDAY MORNING TEAMS DEPART FOR PERTH FROM BUSSELTON

LNJSA teams, coaches and parent helpers will travel together by bus and be accommodated at Christ Church Grammar School and Scotch College, Claremont. After settling in everyone comes together for a group photo and evening meal – BBQ
